002. AUTHORITY AND POWERS

- .1 Authority. The authority to establish, equip, furnish, operate and maintain the public schools of the Bloomsburg Area School District is vested in the Board of School Directors, which is a body corporate and which is constituted and governed by Title 24, the “Public School Code of 1949”, of the Pennsylvania statutes and Article III of the Constitution.
- .2 Powers. The Board shall establish such schools as are required for the education of every person residing in the Bloomsburg Area School District, between the ages of five and 21 years, in kindergarten through twelfth grade, who may attend such schools; shall equip, furnish, operate, and maintain such schools; shall adopt and enforce rules and regulations for the management of school affairs and the conduct and deportment of employees and students; and shall levy and collect such taxes as may be necessary, in addition to the annual state appropriation, for the exercise of aforesaid powers.
