DELAYS AND CLOSINGS

SCHOOL DELAYS AND CLOSINGS: In the event of inclement weather or other emergencies, it may be necessary to change the school day schedule. A phone call will be placed to parents using the "One Call" system. "One Call" sign up forms are in the office and need to be updated separately from the biographical data system. In addition to this, parents are encouraged to check local listings (TV and radio) on a regular basis for school delays and closings. Information is also available on the Memorial Elementary Facebook page.

DELAYED OPENING: A delayed opening means that schools open either one, two, or three hours later than scheduled. In the event of a one-hour delay, school doors will open at 9:15 a.m. The 6 buses will come to your child's stop one hour later than normal. In the event of a two-hour delay, school doors will open at 10:15 a.m. The buses will come to your child's stop two hours later than normal. In the event of a three-hour delay, school doors will open at 11:15 a.m. The buses will come to your child's stop three hours later than normal. Staff will not be available to supervise children before the times listed above. Breakfast will not be provided when the school is operating on a delayed opening.

EARLY DISMISSAL: Early dismissal times will be announced using the One-Call system and local television and radio stations. Please make sure transportation information is up to date with the office in the event of an early dismissal. All buses operate on that same early schedule. When elementary schools close early due to the weather, all after school programs and evening events are cancelled.
