


Monday 3/2 - <u>Cat in the Hat</u> - wear your red and white and maybe even a hat. Students will be selecting a free book courtesy of the PTO.

Bloomsburg Area School District Kindergarten Registration Dates:

- Monday, May 4- Beaver-Main Elementary School
- Tuesday, May 5– Memorial Elementary School
- Wednesday, May 6

 Memorial Elementary School
 - Thursday, May 7-W.W. Evans Elementary School

We look forward to welcoming our Little Panthers, Class of 2033, this fall. As part of the process, BASD will be registering kindergarten students for the 2020-2021 school year during the week of May 4, <u>by appointment only</u>. To be eligible for admittance to kindergarten in the Bloomsburg Area School District, a child must be five years of age before September 1, 2020.

Registration for all children will be in the attendance area in which they reside. Those living in the Town of Bloomsburg and Wonderview will register at Bloomsburg Memorial Elementary School (570-784-7885); Hemlock and Montour Townships at W. W. Evans Elementary School (570-784-3167); and Beaver and Main Townships at Beaver-Main Elementary School (570-784-0309). Parents must call the school their child will be attending to make an appointment to register their child.

To complete the registration process, parents or legal guardians must bring their child's birth certificate or other acceptable proof of child's date of birth, immunization record, and proof of residency. Parents or legal guardians must submit ONE of the following documents as proof of

residency: Real estate tax bill, signed lease, or mortgage document or payment book/coupon; OR TWO of the following documents: Gas/electric bill, voter registration card, phone bill (landline only), food stamp card, vehicle registration, bank statement, homeowner/rental insurance, water bill, cable bill, public aid/Medicaid card, credit card statement, paycheck stub, or driver's license/state identification card.
