We realize that technology has aided all of us with communication. Many of us have replaced home phones with cell phones and look to social media for information. That said, the importance of keeping contact information and records updated at the school office is vital, not only for the school itself, but for the safety of your child. Phone numbers and addresses on file at the school are used in the event of an emergency, if contact is needed due to a sick child, and even at the state level for accurate educational record keeping.
