214. CLASS RANK

- .1 The Board acknowledges the usefulness of a system of computing grade point averages and class ranking for secondary school graduates to inform students, parents and others of their relative academic placement among their peers under relatively similar circumstances.
- .2 The Board authorizes a system of class ranking, by grade point average, for students in grades 9 to 12.
- .3 All students shall be ranked together by grade level.
- .4 Class rank shall be computed by the final grade in all subjects for which credit is awarded. An exception to this occurs at the 12th grade level where the mid-year grade is used for final class rank.
- .5 Any two or more students whose computed grade point averages are identical shall be given the same rank. The number of students preceding his/her and not by the rank of the person preceding him/her will determine the rank of the student who immediately follows a tied position.
- .6 A student's grade point average and rank in class shall be entered on his/her record and shall be subject to the Board's policy on release of student records.
