

Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Grant Writing Monthly Board Report

K-8 ELA and Math Curriculum Development

As these teams have wound down their resource selections, they have begun to write a coherent scope and sequence for both Math and ELA in grades K-8. These documents are a work-in-progress and will provide a basis for instructional content and pacing during the 2022-2023 school year. We are currently targeting the end of June for completion, but are hoping to be finished sooner.

Following the completion of this, all Math and ELA teachers of grades K-8 will be provided with paid time for curriculum and resource familiarization over the summer, according to their own schedules.

K-8 ELA and Math Curriculum Resources

Both the K-8 ELA and Math committees have identified their preferred resources. I have been working with the companies to produce quotes for all components and will be finalizing these in the coming weeks. As you know, this is an important investment on the part of the District, and teachers who wanted to take part all had the opportunity to do so. The teams have worked over our last several in-service days as well as several times outside of contracted time.

During our June work session meeting, the curricular items will be available for both board and public review per our District policy. We would like to be able to vote on resources at the June Board Meeting.

Secondary Scopes and Sequences

Teachers at the secondary level, outside of 6-8 ELA and 6-8 Math, have been asked to create a document that reflects the curricular framework for all classes taught in the Middle and High Schools. These documents will then be readily available on the District website, under a Curriculum page, for public review. This website will be completed by the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year.
