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**206. ASSIGNMENT WITHIN DISTRICT**

- .1 The Board directs that the assignment of students to schools within this district be consistent with proper education of students and the best use of the resources of this district.
- .2 The Board shall determine periodically the school attendance areas of the district and shall expect the students within each area to attend the school so designed.
  - .21 The grade level organization of the Bloomsburg Area School District shall include kindergarten through fifth grade in elementary schools, sixth through eighth in a middle school, and grades nine through twelve in a senior high school.
  - .22 Beaver-Main Elementary School shall house an educational program for all children residing in Beaver and Main Townships, with the exception of children from Wonderview, and that portion of Catawissa Township that is included in the Bloomsburg Area School District, who attend Bloomsburg Memorial Elementary School.
  - .23 W. W. Evans Memorial Elementary School shall house an educational program for all children residing in Hemlock and Montour Townships.
  - .24 Bloomsburg Memorial Elementary School shall house an educational program for all children residing within the incorporated limits of the Town of Bloomsburg, plus Wonderview, and that portion of Catawissa Township that is included in the Bloomsburg Area School District.
  - .25 Bloomsburg Area Middle School shall house an educational program in the designated grades for all students of the district.

- .26 Bloomsburg Area High School shall also house an educational program in the designated grades for all students of the district.
- .3 The Superintendent shall periodically review existing attendance areas and recommend to the Board such changes as may be justified by:
  - .31 considerations of safe student transportation and travel
  - .32 convenience of access of schools
  - .33 financial and administrative efficiency
  - .34 the effectiveness of the instructional program
- .4 The Superintendent may assign a student to a school other than that designated by the attendance area when such exception is justified by circumstances and is in the proper educational interest of the student.
- .5 The building principal shall assign incoming transfer students to such groups, grades and classes as may afford each student the greatest likelihood of realizing fullest educational potential.
- .6 The building principal shall assign students in his/her school to appropriate grades, classes or groups. This action shall be based on consideration of the needs of the student as well as the administration of the school.
