234. PREGNANT STUDENTS

- .1 No student, whether married or unmarried, who is otherwise eligible to attend the schools of this district shall be denied an educational program solely because of pregnancy, childbirth, pregnancy-related disabilities, or actual or potential parenthood; nor shall a pregnant student under the age of 17 be excused from the requirements of the Compulsory Attendance Statute solely for reasons of her pregnancy or maternity.
- .2 A pregnant student whose mental or physical condition prevents her from attending regular classes may be assigned to an alternate educational program, such as homebound instruction, when a physician certifies such condition.
- .3 A student who has received an alternate educational program, for reasons associated with her pregnancy, shall be readmitted to the regular school program upon her request, and the written statement of a physician that she is physically fit to do so; but unless extenuating circumstances are certified by the physician, the student must re-enroll in the regular program within two months after termination of pregnancy.
